We are pleased to inform you that the U.S. Board on Geographic Names, at its April 10, 2014 meeting, approved your proposal to apply the new name Gilbert Creek to a stream in Orleans County. The name has been entered into the Geographic Names Information System, the nation's official geographic names repository, which is available and searchable online at <http://geonames.usgs.gov>. The entry reads as follows:

Gilbert Creek: stream; 6.5 mi. long; heads in Gaines Township at 43°16'56"N, 78°11'03"W, flows N then NNE into Carlton Township to enter Marsh Creek 2.4 mi. S of Lake Ontario; the name honors Elizabeth Gilbert, first pioneer settler in Orleans County; Orleans County, New York; 43°20'29"N, 78°07'59"W; USGS map – Kent 1:24,000.
