

LEGAL NOTICE

ANNUAL ELECTION OF THE ALBION JOINT FIRE DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual Election of the Albion Joint Fire District will take place on December 10, 2024 between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Hoag Library, 134 S. Main Street, Albion, New York 14411 for the purpose of electing the following fire district officers:

One Fire Commissioner for a five (5) year term, commencing January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2029;

One Fire Commissioner for a four (4) year term, commencing January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2028;

One Fire Commissioner for a three (3) year term, commencing January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2027;

One Fire Commissioner for a two (2) year term, commencing January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2026;

One Fire Commissioner for a one (1) year term, commencing January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025;

One Fire District Treasurer for a three (3) year term, commencing January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2027.

Pursuant to Town Law 174(2), the person receiving the greatest number of votes for the office of fire commissioner shall be elected for a term of five years; the person receiving the second highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of four years; the person receiving the third highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of three years; the person receiving the fourth highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of two years and the person receiving the fifth highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of one year.

All candidates for a District Office shall be residents of the Albion Joint Fire District, not convicted of any degree of arson and file in writing their name, the position and term they are seeking with the Secretary of the Albion Joint Fire District, at P.O. Box 2, Albion, New York 14411 and actually received by the Fire District Secretary on or before 5:00 p.m. on November 20, 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that at such annual election, the following Proposition authorizing the establishment of reserve funds shall also be submitted to the qualified voters of the Albion Joint Fire District for approval:

Proposition A: Shall the Albion Joint Fire District establish an "Apparatus Repair and Replacement Capital Reserve Account" for the purpose of accumulating the capital reserves of the Fire District in order to maintain, repair, improve and replace the apparatus and motor

vehicles of the Fire District; establish an “Equipment Repair and Replacement Capital Reserve Account” for the purpose of accumulating the capital reserves of the Fire District in order to maintain, repair, improve and replace the equipment of the Fire District; establish a “Building Repair and Replacement Capital Reserve Account” for the purpose of accumulating the capital reserves of the Fire District in order to maintain, repair, improve and replace the buildings and grounds of the Fire District; and establish a Repair Reserve Fund pursuant to General Municipal Law 6-d for the purpose of accumulating the reserves of the Fire District for the purpose of maintaining the operations of the Fire District as required by law?

Any elector of the Albion Joint Fire District who shall be registered voter with the Orleans County Board of Elections on or prior to November 18, 2024 and who shall have resided in the Albion Joint Fire District for at least thirty days preceding such election shall be qualified to vote.
